

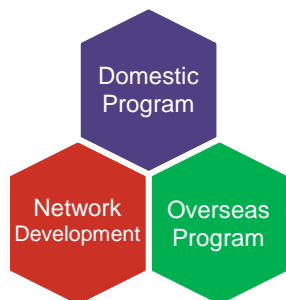


# 2018

## *The Training Program for Top Management of University*

Funded by Ministry of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology JAPAN

Under the strong demand of strengthen of the global innovation force in the Japanese society, university reforms are on-going. In Japanese universities, the cultivation of next-generation talent for university management and expanding of global research is a top-priority issue. Facing the issue, the Training Program for Top Management of University has started in 2016 and 22 future leaders of national university recommended by the president participates in the 2018 program.



### Three Main Components in the Program

- I. Domestic program offer multiple lectures and workshops to learn basic knowledge related to university managements
- II. Overseas Program visit overseas top research universities to see and experience president or provost offices
- III. Development of Network develop a network with overseas university leaders or between participants

### Goals of the Program

- I. To develop human resource for future university management
- II. To support the creation of innovation by utilizing the retained intellectual property in Japanese universities
- III. To improve a system of nation-wide university management
- IV. To learn changing overseas university management along the global competition
- V. To provide a platform to access the world-top university management

## Domestic Program

To provide participants with the basic knowledge necessary for carrying out strategic management of the university, preliminary learning for overseas programs, and the opportunity of sharing participants' experiences in university management, the domestic program will be offered four times a year.

- I. Open seminar by global top leaders
- II. Lectures and workshops by former university presidents, experts from industry and researchers
- III. Closed workshop between overseas university leaders and participants

## Overseas Program

Learn the university management system which is undergoing a major change under global competition taking an American research university, in which subsidies from state governments suddenly stagnated in the past two decades, as an example, and provide the opportunity to build network with the leadership of overseas universities, the long-and short-term program will be planned in US, Canada, and Singapore.

- I. Long-term Program
  - UC San Diego (6 days)
  - National University of Singapore (4 days)
- II. Short-term Program
  - UC Berkeley and Stanford University (3.5 days)
  - University of Chicago (2 days)
  - University of Waterloo (2 days)

## Network Development

To provide platform for information exchange and networking among participants in this training program and to build international network of university managers, the opportunity will be designed in the program.
